EVERY MINUTE MATTERS PROJECTS:

Renovated Kids' Space

The kids' area will be totally isolated and secure for the safety of each and every child. The atrium and welcome area will be expanded creating a primary kids' entrance. There will be cosmetic and room upgrades allowing for at least 450 children in attendance at a time.







• Weekday Preschool

We will launch a weekday preschool,
The Deb Wides Learning Center, in
the newly renovated Kids' space. As
Every Minute Matters, we hope to
have the opportunity to influence and
share the gospel with kids and families
through the impact of a preschool.
The preschool will be named The Deb
Wides Learning Center in honor of
the legacy of Deb Wides, former Kids'
Director at Christ Community Chapel.

• Updated Sanctuary

The sanctuary space will be transformed and updated. We will move from pews to theater seating, new carpeting and improved surfaces. House and stage lighting upgrades allowing for a safer and more navigable space.





• New adult classrooms

Spaces will be updated with cosmetic improvements. There will be updates in the hallways to make them more navigable for guests and allowing for improved spaces to gather outside of classrooms.

New office space

An attached office building allows for the reworking of the kids' space and adult classrooms.

FAQ FOR EVERY MINUTE MATTERS INITIATIVE

How much time do I have to fulfill my giving commitment?

It is a two-year campaign ending on May 1, 2027. After you make your commitment our finance team will reach out with a form to gather information on how and when you plan to give your commitment. This is being done to help us plan for when we will be able to work on the different projects.

CCC has always emphasized reaching non-Christians with the gospel. Does Every Minute Matters reinforce reaching lost people or is it more insular in its focus?

The Every Minute Matters initiative simultaneously provides greater space and opportunities for our own church family while also giving greater opportunity to invite non-Christian neighbors into our space and programs. From the preschool to the indoor playground, from the artificial turf field to an improved sanctuary, we gain increased opportunities to give the gospel to our own church members and those outside of our church family.

Would transitioning to a remote work model be a beneficial alternative to constructing an office building?

One of the best things about CCC is the team of staff who work and serve here. Collaboration and the time we spend working together allows us to do all that we do. An in-person workplace culture is foundational to who we are.

Are we planning to start a preschool to increase income at CCC?

The starting of a preschool is solely connected to our vision that Every Minute Matters for the kids in the region. Having kids with whom we can share the hope of the gospel at a young age and in a preschool format is why we are starting the preschool, not for any income. Our intention is to cover the cost of day-to-day operations through tuition income.

Will the sanctuary project expand seating?

We can currently seat approximately 750 people in the sanctuary. With the addition of theater seating and construction to the space, we will expand that to 1,000 people at a given time. We are evaluating the best ways to plan for continued growth and solutions to accommodating everyone who comes through the doors of CCC.

Could investing this money in missions create a greater impact?

In 2021, with the launch of Reimagine, we set out to strategically and aggressively give to missions around the world with the hope of giving 30 million dollars over the course of 30 years. We believe we are in step with God's heart for missions both globally and locally through the intentionality of this goal and plan and believe, by God's grace, that the investment into the Every Minute Matters projects will bring about significant impact for our community and region.

Will there be enough adult classroom space?

We are presently limited in adult classroom space because of the demand for kids' space with increasing numbers of kids and families. The Every Minute Matters initiative allows for designated adult classroom space and eliminates anyone needing to use stairs to attend an adult class.

When will construction begin on the building and/or field?

We do not have any exact dates yet, but our hope is to begin construction in August 2025 should the Every Minute Matters initiative be successful.
